UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Wrist band clarification: Front desk employee will put wrist band on guest when guest is checked in by resident. The bands are all day passes but if guest leaves the facility resident must return with guest to check in. Resident does not have to stay with guest unless the guest is under the age of 18.

Ball machine is working, there is a committee of people who can help if we want to use it. Names of committee members will be posted on our website.
